

## Page 265, exercise 2

---

- a. When Cleomenes had fled, the rest followed.
- b. Since the pirates had advanced very quickly, the last ships of the Romans were first in danger.
- c. Although the general had quickly reached shore, the rest sailed more slowly.  
[Note the very late position of the conjunction *cum*; see note 4 on page 265.]
- d. When Cleomenes had arrived on shore with his ship, he hid at home.
- e. The rest also, since they had not been able to escape the pirates in any way by sea, left their ships behind.
- f. The leader of the pirates ordered the ships which had been captured to be burnt.

I also assigned exercise 3, on page 266, but won't give you the answers to that just now—the better to have plenty of mistakes to go over in class.
